## MASAI MARA EXPERIENCE 2017



### DAY 1 - MARA SAROVA CAMP

Your parents will drop you at school at 7.30 am for a briefing on the tour. Afterwards you will board the bus and drive through Westlands to the Rift Valley Viewpoint where you will have a stopover. Afterwards, continue past Kedong Valley, through Suswa Plains to Narok town. From there you will proceed to the world renowned Maasai Mara Game Reserve. This is the extension of Serengeti National Park in Tanzania. A geopolitical border which animals are not aware of separates the two parks. It is the most popular game reserve in Eastern Africa. One of the greatest spectacles in the world takes place here from July to October, when wildebeests, antelopes and zebras move from the Serengeti to the Mara. The sheer number of animals is astounding. The park has the largest population of cats; lions are easy to spot and cheetahs are numerous although elusive. In all some 95 species of animals have been noted in Maasai Mara. You will have your lunch at a picnic site on the way. Arrive at the lodge and check in followed by game viewing drive later in the evening. Animals expected to be seen here include lion, hyena, cheetah, elephant and giraffes among others. Dinner and overnight will be at *Mara Sarova Tented Camp*.

### DAY 2 - MARA SAROVA CAMP

The day unfolds with a sumptuous buffet breakfast in the lodge. Afterwards you will drive to the famous Mara River in search of hippos and crocodiles, with a game drive enroute. You will pass through the Kenya-Tanzania border that divides Mara and Serengeti plains. You will return to the lodge for lunch. Early afternoon at leisure in the late afternoon proceed on a game drive probably in search of animals not seen so far. Dinner and overnight will be at *Mara Sarova Tented Camp*.

### **DAY 3 - NAIROBI**

Afterwards drive back to Nairobi with packed lunches where you will be dropped at your school to be picked by your parents.

- ❖ *Kids to carry packed lunches on the first day so that the camp can offer them packed lunches on the last day.*
